CREATIVE RESISTANCE WORKSHOP

This workshop is part of an <u>ongoing series</u> designed to bring artists working with technology together in small groups to talk through notions of creative resistance and critical art practice: what it means, how they practice it, what it does well, and where it might fall short of bringing about structural change.

Together, we will discuss and evaluate the ups and downs of the strategies and technologies we use, and work to draft a manifesto detailing the things that are important to us, the commitments we are willing to make in our practices, and the changes we'd like to see in the tech art landscape.

Frankenthaler Climate Art Awards

Selected by a jury comprised of leaders from the collaborating institutions, three artists will receive \$15,000 and be honored in April 2022 at the Kennedy Center in Washington, D.C., as part of the programming around Coal + Ice, an exhibition featuring work by more than 40 documentary photographers and video artists from around the world that helps visualize the climate crisis.

The initiative is presented in collaboration with the Hirshhorn Museum and Sculpture Garden, the The John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts, National Gallery of Art, and The Phillips Collection. The Environmental Defense Fund will share expertise and propagate the award in the environmental community.
