### Fulbright Scholarship Program

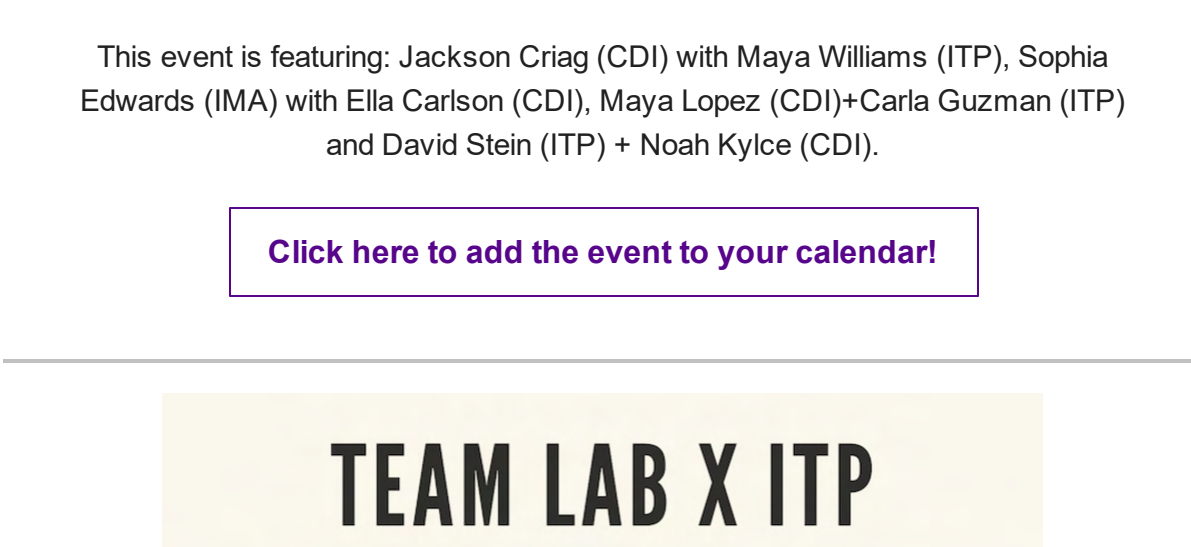

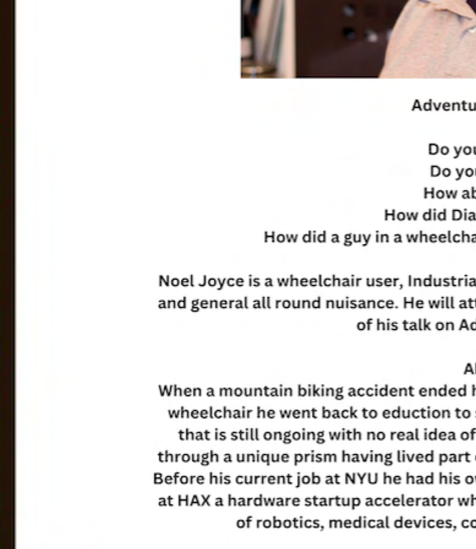
### Relationships Among People - A Talk with TeamLab

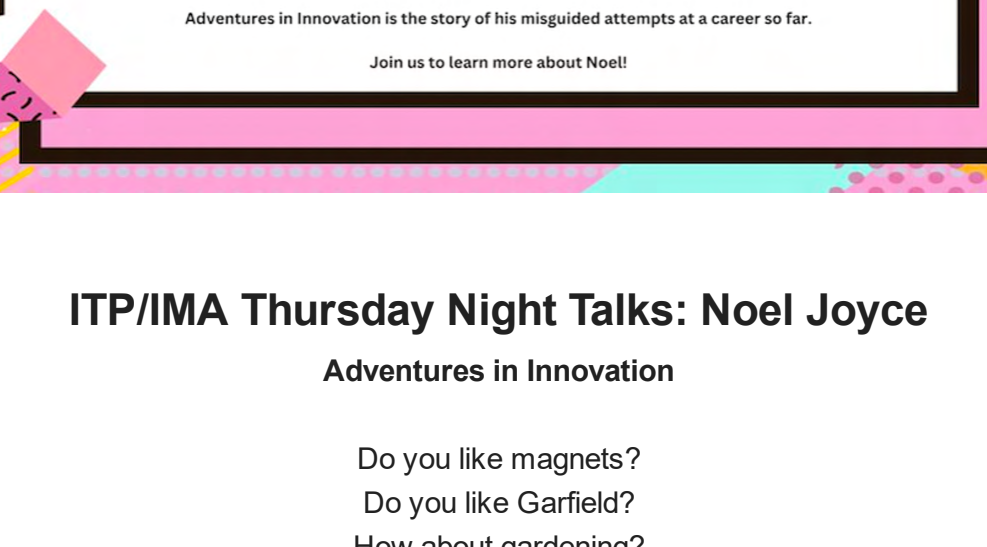

### Yoga Thursdays

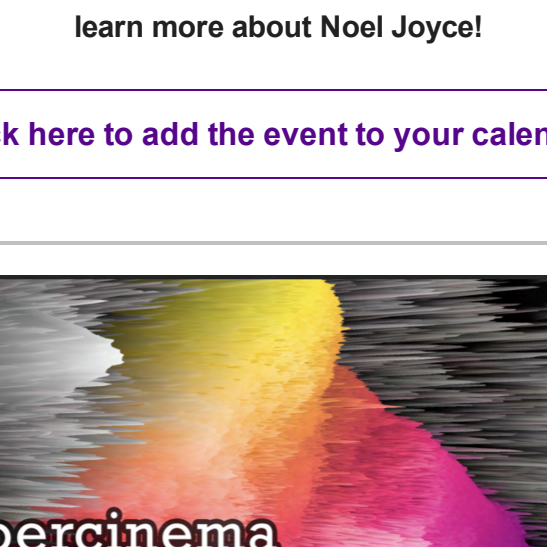

**About Noel:**  
When a mountain biking accident ended his career in the military and left him confined to a wheelchair he went back to education to study design. This was the beginning of a journey that is still ongoing with no real idea of where or when it will end. Noel views the world through a unique prism having lived part of his life able bodied and part of it with disability. Before his current job at NYU he had his own startups and went on to become head of design at HAX a hardware startup accelerator where he worked with over 200 startups in the areas of robotics, medical devices, consumer products as well as many more.

Adventures in Innovation is the story of his misguided attempts at a career so far.

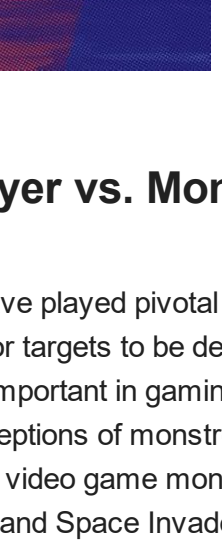

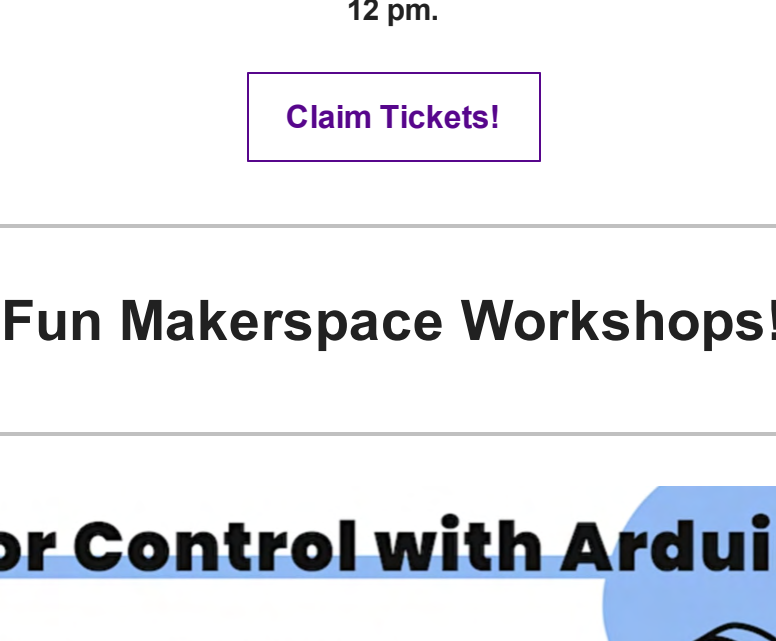

### ITP/IMA Concert ft. Florent Ghys

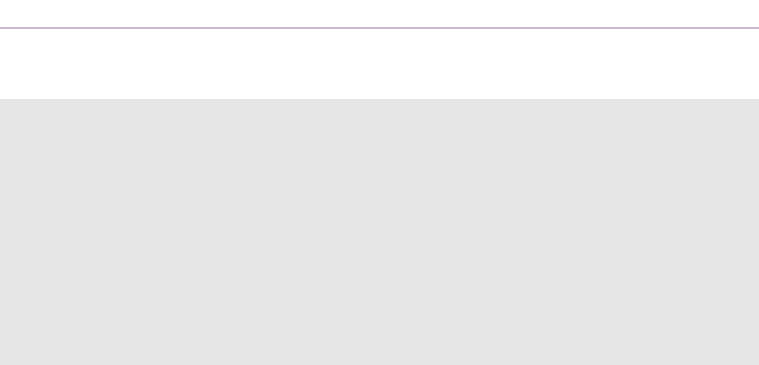

### Jaroslav Švelch Book Talk: Player vs. Monster

Since the early days of video games, monsters have played pivotal roles as dangers to be avoided, level bosses to be defeated, or targets to be destroyed for extra points. But why is the figure of the monster so important in gaming, and how have video games come to shape our culture's conceptions of monstrosity? This talk will explore the cultural roots of contemporary video game monstrosity, focusing on the examples of Dungeons & Dragons and Space Invaders. It will argue that video games follow the Cold War-era notion of clearly defined, calculable enemies. Besides critiquing this simplistic notion of otherness, it will also explore how games can present more original and nuanced depictions of monstrosity.
