The Sustainability Internship Grant was established to provide financial assistance to students pursuing unpaid and low-paying internships in qualifying industries in the sustainability field. The Office of Sustainability is offering a limited number of \$3,000 grants in Summer 2023.

Applications are reviewed by Office of Sustainability staff. Grantees will be required to attend four mandatory professional development sessions that take place on Thursday or Friday afternoons during July and August.

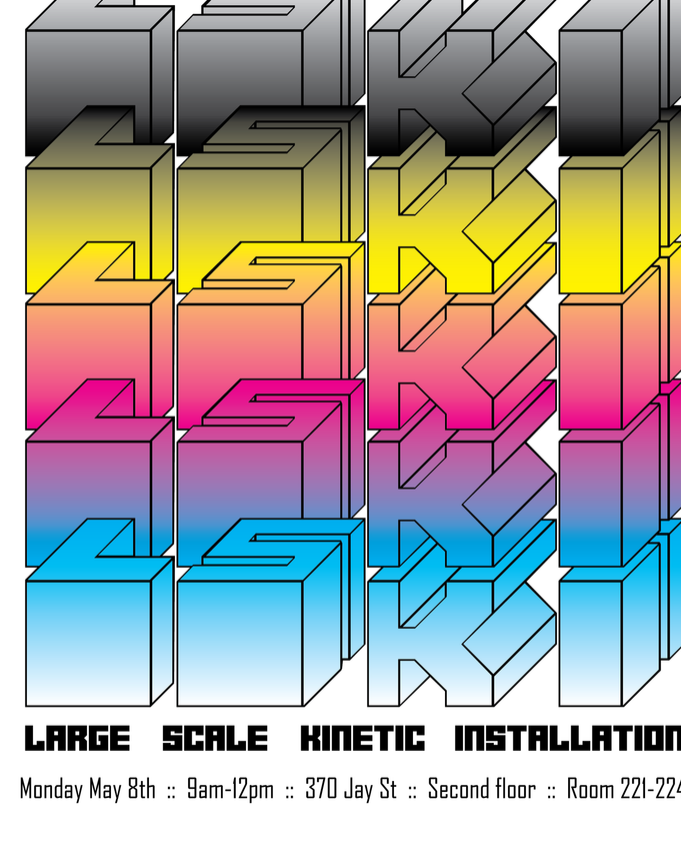

Story Telephone Workshop: ITP/IMA Version

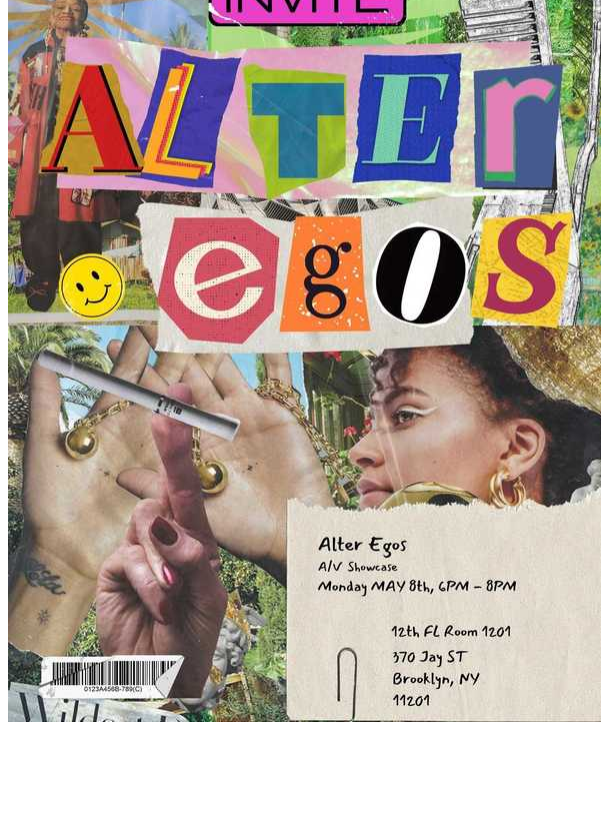
Want a mind detox for a weekday night? Come to play a casual story telephone - a relaxing and fun creative session with friends on the floor!
